



PRESS RELEASE: Call For Submissions 29º SUNCINE

The ACCIONS 3E Non-Profit Cultural Association, with the support of the Generalitat de Catalunya, the Barcelona City Council, the Ministry of Ecological Transition, the Diputació de Barcelona and other public/private institutions, is convening and organizing the 29th SUNCINE International Environmental Film Festival, to be held on November 3-9, 2022.

SUNCINE, formerly known as FICMA, was first held in 1993 and is positioned as the oldest Environmental Film Festival in the world; it is a reference in its genre.

SUNCINE is a multi-screen festival (in-person, online and televised). Its primary objective is to promote, disseminate and publicize environmental audiovisual works to raise awareness about the state of the environment, biodiversity and the planet's sustainability.

All films produced after January 1, 2021 that deal with different social and environmental situations and circumstances anywhere in the world are eligible to participate in the 29th SUNCINE Festival.

The 29th SUNCINE will have three competitive sections:

Official: Documentaries of all nationalities at least 50 minutes long are eligible to participate, aspiring to win the Festival's top award, the Golden Sun. **Views:** 20-50 minute

documentaries of all nationalities that are competing for the "Panda WWF" Prize. **Short films:** Documentaries, fictions and animations of all nationalities up to 20 minutes long are eligible to compete for the "Monarch Prize".
